


Rec/Year 1 Lent 2 Newsletter



Welcome back to school, it is so lovely to see everyone back together in school again but firstly we need to say congratulations to both our keyworker families and those working remotely at home who have coped magnificently- just proves to us what a fantastic community we really are! Thank to those who have returned home learning resources back to school and work books for us all to look at! They are lovely to share with the children but also a really helpful tool assessing the children on their return. This term's topic is 'Can you find your funny bones?' and is driven by science/the natural world, where the children will be learning about the human body. It will also be jam packed with Lent activities, the Easter story and additional wow experiences that will hook the children into their new learning! Our RE focus is 'Growing' and the children will explore Lent and the life of Jesus Christ. This term you will find homework tasks for this term but please see your child's class teacher if you have any queries regarding this.

- The children should have received a set of targets for the Lent term that they are working towards in their diaries. If you would like to discuss their targets in more detail please the class teacher.
- Please note: water and fruit **only** to be sent into school for snack time
- For safety reasons, we ask that fruit is chopped.
- Please do not send in food items with nut traces as we have serious nut allergies in the classes



- Please make sure children bring their book bags to school every day. It is important children have their book bags in school to make sure that all letters make it home safely. If your child has a reading book please make sure this is in their book bag everyday alongside their reading record
- Thank you for social distancing when dropping your children off and collecting them.
- Please can you read with your children at home as much as possible as this will develop both their language and reading skills.
- More information will be put on the class page on the website under Reception/Year 1 heading, so please check on there.
- Class teachers will put stickers in the children's diaries with information on, so please check their diaries for messages from teachers in the messages from school section.

We have now sent reception home with 'Tell me a story' book in to support the children's communication and language development, it would be great if the children can share these with you and complete the story maps as this consolidates their learning in school.

Please note, a good work liturgy video will be sent to you for children who shone brightly in our school community last half term during lockdown. We look forward to finding out will achieve this in Lent 2.

Finally, if there is anything you would like to speak to the class teacher about, please use their reading diaries as a way to communicate as they are checked daily.
