Basic skills – Shape and measure <i>Ongoing (no written work required to be handed in)</i>	<p>I can order two or three items by height or length</p> <p>I can use everyday language related to time. I can measure short periods of time in simple ways.</p>			
Basic Skills – non-negotiable spellings/or a spelling rule <i>Ongoing (no written work required to be handed in)</i>	<p>I can segment the sounds in simple words and blend them together</p> <p>I can link phonemes to graphemes, naming and sounding letters of the alphabet.</p>			
Reading Challenge <i>Ongoing (no written work required to be handed in)</i>	<p><u>Can you listen to stories from beginning to end and answer questions based on the story?</u></p> <p>When you are listening to stories at home- try to listen to the whole story.
