<p>Basic skills – Shape and measure <i>Ongoing (no written work required to be handed in)</i></p>	<p>Can you identify different shapes in the environment?</p> <p>Can you use some positional language when playing? (on top, under, next to, above and beneath etc)</p>			
<p>Basic Skills – non-negotiable spellings/or a spelling rule <i>Ongoing (no written work required to be handed in)</i></p>	<p>Can you write your name?</p> <p>Can you identify initial phonemes? (e.g play 'I Spy... something beginning with S..)</p>			
<p>Reading Challenge <i>Due in Monday 16th October</i></p>	<p><u>Can you talk about a favourite book?</u> Why do you like this story? What happens in the story? Who is in this story? Where is the story set? Eg a forest, castle or garden...</p>
