<p style="text-align: center;">Basic Skills - Number <i>Ongoing (no written work required to be handed in)</i></p>	<p>Can you count forwards and backwards in the 2s and 5s times tables? Recall 5 multiplication and division facts.</p>	<p>"2 x 5 is ? , 5 x 5 is ?"</p>		
<p style="text-align: center;">Basic skills - Time <i>Ongoing (no written work required to be handed in)</i></p>	<p>Can you draw the hands on a clock to show a given time? Do you know what each number means on a clock? Can you say and write the number of minutes in an hour and the number of hours in a day?</p>			
<p style="text-align: center;">Basic Skills - non-negotiable spellings using phonics learnt and tricky phase words. Occasional tests throughout the half term / learnt spellings to be seen spelt correctly in written work</p>	<p>There will be a list of spellings in the back of your child's reading diary. Please spend some time learning these as there will be a spelling bee at the end of the half term.</p>
