How independent have they been? What further learning might they benefit from? Anything else you would like us to know etc.)</i></p>	
<p>Basic Skills – Number Ongoing (no written work required to be handed in)</p>	<p>Can you recall and use multiplication and division facts for the x2 x5 and x10 multiplication tables, including recognising odd and even numbers?</p>	<p>Play a recall game for multiplication and division facts. How many can you do in one minute?</p>		
<p>Basic skills – Shape and measure Ongoing (no written work required to be handed in)</p>	<p><u>Money</u> Can you recognise and use symbols for pounds (£) and pence (p)? Can you combine amounts to make a particular value? Can you add and subtract amounts of money, including giving change?</p>	<p>Use real coins to make different amounts of money. Can you find the total of 2 of your coins? 3 of your coins? Role-play shops – what coins do I need to buy this? What change will I get? Etc.</p>		
<p>Basic Skills – non-negotiable spellings using phonics learnt and tricky phase words.</p>	<p>These spellings are taken from the year 2 common exception word list. They are words that children should be able to spell by the end of year 2. (Also continue to recap previous homework spellings: Door, floor, poor, because, find, kind, mind, behind, child, children, wild, climb, most, only, could, should, would who, Christmas)</p>	<p>Old, cold, told, gold, hold, every, great, steak, break, pretty, beautiful, after, fast, last, past, father, class, grass, pass</p>
