



Subject Specific Vocabulary

emotion	A strong feeling that comes from your circumstances, mood, or relationships with others
change	Make or become different
cope	Dealing with something difficult
anxious	Feeling or showing worry, nervousness, or unease about something with an uncertain outcome
recognise	Identify/spot something they are already familiar with
longitude	To find out how far east or west a place is, lines of longitude are used. These lines run from the top of the Earth to the bottom.
latitude	To find out how far north or south a place is, lines of latitude are used. These lines run parallel to the Equator.
primary source	Primary sources are original records of historical periods or events made by people during an event.
secondary source	Secondary sources are the products of the study of history – they are always based on other sources
cycle	A series of events that are regularly repeated in the same order
longitude	To find out how far east or west a place is, lines of longitude are used. These lines run from the top of the Earth to the bottom.

Recognise problems they may face as they move to a new year group.



Recognise the things they are looking forward to about starting a new year group.

Know what it means to have conflicting feelings and identify some.


Recognise any worries they may have and how to deal with these.
