Pupil Premium Funding

The Academy received £48,800 in pupil premium funding during the academic year of 2013-14. The table below shows how the money was spent.

Issues

Monitoring has demonstrated the need for a focus on the basic skills of oracy, reading, writing and maths. The development of these skills will enable pupils to make further progress in the core subjects.

Following discussion with staff, governors and pupils we feel these skills need to be modelled to a high standard and applied in a range of contexts.

Activity	Expenditure	Rationale
Intervention Activities	£30000	Funding for teachers, teaching assistant, Deputy Head release time to work with groups of children to target
Theatre/drama workshops and trips	£400	Allow pupils to practise their speaking skills for a purpose and in a meaningful context.
Magazines/newspapers	£700	Ensure pupils have a range of texts that are available to them for discussion.
Chaplaincy team provision	£2000	To allow pupils the opportunity to build self-esteem and self-belief through worship and collaboration with peers. Develop team work opportunities and promote the need to present to lead teams of pupils and adults.
Education Welfare support	£1100	Support families who have poor attendance or late issues to ensure that pupils have full access to the curriculum.
Faith in Families	£6300	Providing emotional support to pupils' and families to support their wellbeing both in and out of school.
Outdoor Resources and Provision	£5900	Ensure an environment which is text and talk rich. Development of the outdoor area and play for EYFS, KS1 and 2.
Library resources	£1400	Engaging the pupils in reading for pleasure and purpose across the curriculum.
Funding for trips and activities	£1000	Ensuring that all pupils have full access to the range of extra-curricular activities that are available.
