



Pupil Premium – 2016/17

Pupil Premium Funding

The Academy received £48,080 in pupil premium funding during the academic year of 2016-17. The table below shows how the money was spent.

Issues

Monitoring has demonstrated the need for a focus on the basic skills of oracy, reading and writing. The development of these skills will enable pupils to make further progress in the core subjects.

Following discussion with staff, governors and pupils we feel these skills need to be modelled to a high standard and applied in a range of contexts.

Activity	Expenditure	Rationale
Intervention Activities	£22,035	Funding for teachers, teaching assistant, Deputy Head release time to work with groups of children to target specific academic needs.
ELSA Support and Training	£650	Emotional Literacy Support Assistant. To work with individual children or small groups. This to include supervision by an Educational Psychologist
Rainbows bereavement and Loss Training, resources and support	£2477	Training for whole staff and training for individual facilitators. Purchase of resources to deliver sessions. Minimum of two sessions delivered per year. Two TAs to deliver the hour long sessions
Nurture Support & resources	£8513	Two TAs to deliver nurture sessions (two half days) per week. Training provided from the local authority. Resources for the sessions purchased and weekly snacks to be provided
Resources to support specific intervention	£1600	Specialist resources to promote learning and support with specific needs of individuals such as talking games, communication lego
Sports interventions and resources	£2900	Specialist sports professional to work with specific pupil premium pupils to raise self-esteem, confidence, fine and gross motor skills
Cool Milk	£452	Provide children with a daily amount of milk
Bespoke intervention theatre/drama workshops and trips	£857	Allow pupils to practise their speaking skills for a purpose and in a meaningful context. Visit from a published poet
Magazines/newspapers	£300	Ensure pupils have a range of texts that are available to them for discussion
Chaplaincy team provision	£4791	To allow pupils the opportunity to build self-esteem and self-belief through worship and collaboration with peers. Develop team work opportunities and promote the need to present to lead teams of pupils and adults.
Education Welfare support	£1563	Support families who have poor attendance or late issues to ensure that pupils have full access to the curriculum.
Library resources	£1200	Engaging the pupils in reading for pleasure and purpose across the curriculum.
Funding for educational trips and activities	£675	Ensuring that all pupils have full access to the range of extra-curricular activities that are available.
Bespoke intervention support 1:1	£67	Cooking, shop visits, bus fares etc to support the learning needs of individual
